This authorization applies to the following programs:

- **Conflict Minerals - Dodd-Frank Act 1502:** Suppliers whose products contain tin, tantalum, tungsten, or gold must complete and submit a Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT).
- **PFAS Identification** - Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), including those identified by the U.S. Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) and the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) Global Database of PFAS.

You will receive an email request and see a list of the specific programs applicable to your organization within the supplier portal. Please ensure that you respond to all data and regulatory requests within the specified timelines. Failure to comply may result in formal corrective action. You can also authenticate this Letter of Authorization (LoA) under the “Regulatory Information” section under [Assent Authorization Letter](#).
