

## TSCA Supplier Letter of Compliance

All composite wood products (or components containing them) my company provides to MasterBrand Cabinets LLC are and will be compliant with the emissions levels set forth in the EPA's rule on formaldehyde in composite wood products, 40 CFR Part 770 (the Rule), and if applicable, the Canadian Environmental Act Formaldehyde Emissions from Composite Wood Products Regulation SOR/2021-148. This means;

- 1) all panels must be certified by an EPA-recognized third-party certifier;
- 2) all panels must be tested in accordance with the Rule to show compliance with the formaldehyde emissions limits, using the test methods set forth in the Rule;
- 3) all panels, component parts, and finished goods must be appropriately labeled;
- 4) a statement of compliance must appear on the invoice and/or bill of lading; and
- 5) all suppliers of laminated products to MasterBrand Cabinets LLC are expected to ensure full compliance with all EPA requirements and ensure that all products sold to MasterBrand Cabinets LLC meet the EPA standards.

It is also understood that my company will provide a list of all active mills providing MasterBrand Cabinets LLC with these products, along with the mill's TPC certification, and participate in all required mill validation events. It is also understood that my company will notify MasterBrand Cabinets LLC in regards to any mill additions or deletions, and wait for the appropriate approval from MasterBrand Cabinets LLC before the implementation of these changes. My company understands that its failure to comply with these requirements can result in termination as a MasterBrand Cabinets LLC supplier, and/or chargeback to recover any/all lost revenue and expenses MasterBrand Cabinets LLC incurs as a result of any non-compliance and/or other penalties.
